

CREPUQ - Conférence des recteurs et des principaux des universités du Québec

General Information

The CREPUQ (Conférence des recteurs et des principaux des universités du Québec) is a private institution created in 1963 that comprise all Quebec Universities. It is the main institution that manages academic life in Quebec and also the international relationships with foreign institutions.

CREPUQ offers exchange programs from one semester to a full year; the students get credits from their host university for their diploma at the home university. Student exchange agreements have been signed with over 500 universities or university consortiums in the countries in the European Union (see partners below plus Switzerland), North und South America (Argentina, Brazil, Chile, Colombia, Mexico, United States), and Asia (China, Japan, Taiwan).

These programs allow students who are registered at a university (the home institution) to complete part of their program at another university (the host institution) for a semester up to a full academic year.

When participating in a CREPUQ exchange program, students:

- continue to be registered at their home institution
- pay the usual tuition of their home institution and not the tuition of the host institution
- earn credits from the host institution towards their degree from the home institution, and if applicable, continue to receive financial aid for which they are eligible as students of their home institution

Eligibility Criteria:

The exchange programs are open to students who are registered full-time at a university that has signed the CREPUQ Agreement. (The only restriction regarding field of study is for the medical field: for these studies other agreements are necessary to study abroad.)

- Candidates must satisfy the following conditions:
- Completion of the equivalent of at least one year of full-time study in the program in which they are registered; full-time graduate students are also eligible for these programs
- Full-time registration in the same program while they are attending the host institution
- Good academic standing (an average grade between 2.7 and 3.0/4, depending on the home university)
- Fluency in the language used at the host institution
- Approval from the home institution of the courses they plan to take at the host institution

Student Mobility in Numbers

The number of students from each Partner Institution is flexible and basically unrestricted. Usually the number of students coming to Quebec is up to four or five times as high as the number of outgoing students to all partner institutions in the world. However in both direction numbers are steadily increasing over the last 5 years. The biggest group of incoming students comes from French Partner Institutions.

Eligibility

Any full-time student with a 70% cumulative GPA, enrolled in their first degree, is eligible to apply to participate in the exchange programme.

Most students who participate in an exchange usually go in either the second year of a three-year Bishop's degree, or the third year of a four-year degree. However, other arrangements are possible.

Scholarships

Nuevos Recuerdos Bursary

Nuevos Recuerdos will be awarded annually as a travel grant in the amount of \$1,000 to a student pursuing a major in Hispanic Studies who plans to participate in an International Exchange in Spain for one or two semesters. Application for this bursary is available to Bishop's University students who have been admitted to participate in an international exchange for the Fall and or Winter academic semesters.

Bishop's University Scholarship Renewal

A student on a recognized Bishop's Exchange must complete a 30 credit (or equivalent, determined by the Divisional Dean) course load at the exchange institution with a first class average for awards under \$3 000 or with an average equivalent to 85% for awards \$3 000 or more.

Final year students may also apply but should take special care to observe the academic regulations for graduation. Graduate and International degree-seeking students are also encouraged to apply. Graduate students may participate in the ISEP for one semester only.

Financial Support

Ministry of Quebec Education - Student Mobility Bursary

The Ministry of Quebec Education (MEQ) offers a Student Mobility Bursary to students who qualify as Quebec residents and are contemplating studying outside of Quebec. The MEQ bursary is awarded to qualified students regardless of the amount of governmental or personal funding declared in the Affidavit of Finances.

L'Office Franco-Quebecois Pour La Jeunesse (OFQJ)

Students electing to study in France may be eligible for a special travel/orientation package offered by the OFQJ. This package includes significantly reduced airfare (round trip) to France, a pre-departure orientation session, and one night's accommodation in Paris. Students must be between 18 - 35 years of age, be a Canadian citizen or permanent resident and have remained in Quebec for at least one year. This offer is on a first-come first-served basis as availability is limited to approximately 250 places for the participating Quebec institutions. Priority is given to CREPUQ partner applicants.

Eligibility Criteria

Be enrolled full-time and will remain enrolled full-time time [Undergraduates: 12 credits per semester for 2 consecutive semesters / Graduates: 8 credits (one semester)] prior to ISEP participation;

- Have successfully completed a minimum 24 Concordia University undergraduate credits or 8 graduate credits by the time the ISEP begins;
- Be in good academic standing at Concordia University and have the minimum Grade Point Average (GPA) of:

- Arts and Science GPA 2.5 (B-, C+)

- Fine Arts GPA 2.7 (B-, C+)
- John Molson School of Business GPA 3.0 (B)

Financial support

1. Faculty of Engineering - Antje Graupe Pryor Awards

Established in 1999 by a generous gift from the Werner Graupe and the Antje Graupe Pryor Foundation. Awarded by the Faculty of Engineering Scholarships Committee to second or third year McGill Engineering students to continue their engineering studies in a German or French university for one or two semesters. Preference is given to students wishing to continue their studies at German universities, particularly Technische Universitat Berlin. Students in Chemical and Civil Engineering are not eligible.

Value: \$7 500 for one semester; renewable for a second semester.

2. Awards for Quebec Residents

Number of Grants Available

Up to 250-300 terms (maximum of two terms per student)

Amounts Available

Up to \$750 per month for a period of two to eight months (the amount per month is dependent upon the exchange destination and the funds available). Certain other sources of funding may be deducted.

Eligibility

- Open to Quebec residents (as defined by the rules established by the Ministry of Education of Quebec) pursuing an Exchange or Study Abroad program outside the province of Quebec.
- Undergraduate students must have completed 24 McGill credits towards their McGill degree prior to their participation in an exchange program outside of the province of Quebec.
- Masters and PhD students must 1) not be registered in an additional session, and 2) have completed nine credits of course work for non-thesis programs and one full-time term for thesis programs at the time of application.
- Students must have a cumulative GPA greater than 2.7.
- Students must be pursuing full-time studies while enrolled in an Exchange or Study Abroad program outside the province of Quebec.
- Students must receive full-time transfer credit towards their McGill degree program requirements. Full-time equivalent transfer credit is three (3) credits per month of fulltime study at the host institution.
- Students who decide to take more credits than required in order to graduate will not be eligible to receive the MEQ award for these additional credits.

Priority will be given to students whose study abroad experience is deemed integral to their program of study.

George Burris Study in England Grant

The George Burris Study in England Grant has been establised by a bequest from George Burris to support Dalhousie Students wishing to study in England as part of their academic program. Grants will be awarded on the basis of academic and extraccurricular excellence, financial need, and international experience.

There are two types of George Burris awards:

1. George Burris Study in England Entrance Scholarship

The George Burris Study in England Entrance Scholarship is open to Canadian students in their final year of high school who have applied for admission to Dalhousie University and who hope to participate in the First Year Program at the International Study Centre (ISC). These scholarships are for promising students for whom the cost of attending the ISC may be a barrier.

The Marguerite and Leroy Zwicker Fellowship was established in 1992 in memory of Leroy Zwicker (1906-1988) and Marguerite Zwicker (1904-1993), both graduates of NSCAD and dedicated to promoting the visual arts in the Maritimes and to supporting and encouraging young artists. The fellowship is intended to assist NSCAD students of outstanding academic achievement in the undertaking of Independent off campus study or exchange study outside North America.

The Roloff Beny Photography Scholarships have been made possible through the generous donation of the Roloff Beny Foundation in Toronto. Two \$5 000 scholarships will be awarded for the academic year. ^{*} The Frecker Program is based on a private agreement between MUN and the Francoforum, an institution founded by the French Service de l'Éducation Nationale in Saint-Pierre. The Frecker Program is offered under the terms of a protocole d'entente, which is renewed on a yearly basis.

Eligibility:

The prerequisite for admission to the Frecker Program are successful completion of MUN French 1502 with a minimum mark of 65% or permission of the Head of the Department, and good academic standing.

Fees:

Students are required to pay tuition and student fees, plus \$ 2 000 program fee to cover travel to and from Saint-Pierre, textbooks, a portion of room and board, program activities, and so forth.

Financial assistance:

The Provincial government provides funding to the Program in the amount of \$ 2 000 per students. Also, the Faculty of Arts offers student loans upon the loan application.

** The Lycée d'État in Saint-Pierre and Miquelon program is financed under a reciprocal agreement between the provincial government of Newfoundland and Labrador and the authorities in saint-Pierre, which also allows for up to four saint-Pierre students to spend a full academic year at a post-secondary institution in Newfoundland. A MOU between the Service de l'Éducation Nationale in Saint-Pierre and MUN also allows one MUN student per year to be appointed as Assistant of a foreign language at the Lycée d'État between January and June. The general intergovernmental agreement has been in place for many years and has no time limit. The MUN Service de l'Éducation Nationale MOU has just been renewed for a period of four years.

Eligibility:

Students who wish to participate in the program should have completed at least MUN French 3100 or 3101.

Financial assistance:

Third year study abroad program - semester(s) in France

The exchange is based on a 5-year contract for the 2002-2007 period. It was reached and is supervised by the Tourism Department on behalf of Holland College.

In 2005, one Canadian student went to IMC and four Austrian students came to Holland College.

Eligibility:

To be eligible for the exchange program, students must have obtained good academic standing and a basic knowledge of German.

Scholarships and Awards

Association of Universities and Colleges of Canada

The Association of Universities and Colleges of Canada administers more than 150 scholarship programs on behalf of the federal government, domestic and foreign agencies and private sector companies. DFAIT Scholarship Programs

The federal Department of Foreign Affairs and International Trade (DFAIT) offers a number of funding opportunities for Canadians wanting to study or conduct research abroad and international students willing to study in Canada.

I. Government of Canada Awards Program

These awards, tenable only in Canada, are intended to enable foreign students of high academic standing to undertake graduate studies or post doctoral research in Canadian institutions. Awards may be applied to research or studies in all areas of the arts, the social sciences and humanities, commerce, the natural sciences and engineering. Proposed programs of study must focus on a Canadian subject or include significant Canadian content. Awards are available to citizens of France, Germany and Italy.

Terms of the awards

Research scholarships include a monthly living allowance of \$1 200 CAD, plus tuition and registration fees, where applicable. Research scholarships are granted for a minimum period of six months to a maximum period of twelve months and are not renewable. Post- doctoral fellowships receive \$1 300 CAD per month. The tenure of these awards is normally for a minimum of four months to a maximum of six months. A small number of full scholarships are also offered to pursue a master's or doctoral program at a Canadian university. They include a monthly living allowance of \$1 200, plus tuition and registration fees, where applicable. Initially awarded for a maximum period of twelve months, some scholarships may be renewed for one additional year.

II. Foreign Government Awards

This award is intended to assist Canadian students to further their studies or conduct research abroad at the master's, doctoral or post-doctoral level. The governments of Finland, France, Germany, Italy, Netherlands and Spain offer awards to Canadian graduate students.

Terms of the awards

Although all of the awards are similar in nature, the value of each award is determined by the offering country. Most awards cover travel to and from the host country, tuition and registration fees, and a monthly living allowance. Several awards also cover books, mandatory health and accident insurance and various other allowances. Most countries offer a wide selection of disciplines to which awards may be applied, but not all countries offer awards for all disciplines. The awards normally cover a period of at least six months. For complete details on all awards please consult the website below.

III. Commonwealth Scholarship Plan

These awards are available to Canadians citizens and in certain cases permanent residents of Canada for graduate study (Masters or Ph.D.) or research in Commonwealth countries. Applicants must have completed a university degree or expect to graduate prior to the commencement of the award.

IV. Canadian Commonwealth Scholarship Program

The Canadian Commonwealth Scholarship Program (CCSP) is designed to provide opportunities for students of other Commonwealth countries to pursue advanced programs of study or research in Canada. The scholarships are intended for men and women of high intellectual promise who may be expected to make a significant contribution to their own countries on their return from study in Canada. To be eligible a student must hold a Bachelor's or Master's degree from a recognized university or some equivalent qualification. Each scholarship is intended to cover the expenses of travel, living and study.

CBIE International Learning Grants

The Canadian Bureau for International Education's (CIBE) International Learning Grants enable undergraduate students to finance the additional costs associated with international learning, e.g. travel and living costs. There are two types of grants available for individual applicants: Grants are available for individual applicants for programs of two weeks minimum to less than four months, or for programs of more than four months (one or two semesters).

Eligibility and terms of award

Canadian citizens and permanent residents enrolled in a full-time undergraduate program at a CBIE member institution and accepted in an exchange program organized by this school are eligible. Programs may be study, study-internships or internships. Research-only programs are not eligible. While all fields of study are eligible, priority will go to international education and international relations, or other programs integrating international issues. The value of grants for Individual programs of two weeks minimum to less than 4 months are \$500. Individual programs of more than 4 months are awarded grants of \$ 2 500.

Queen Elizabeth II Silver Jubilee Endowment Fund for Study in a Second Official Language Award Program

The goal of this award is to encourage young Canadians who whish to improve their proficiency in their second official language at another university which functions in the other official language

Eligibility requirements

Candidates must be Canadian citizens or permanent residents and be enrolled in the 2nd or 3rd year of their first undergraduate university program. Candidates must have sufficient ability in their second official language to pursue their studies in that language. All disciplines, except translation are eligible for this award.

Duration and terms of the award

Annually there is a maximum of 3 three awards available. The value of the grant is \$5 000 plus travel costs. Applications are by nomination by the candidate's university. Each university can nominate one candidate.

Queen Elizabeth II British Columbia Centennial Scholarship

This scholarship intends to enable students from British Columbia to pursue graduate studies in a Commonwealth country other than Canada

Eligibility requirements

Graduate students with an undergraduate degree from a British Columbia public post-secondary institution who have their domicile in the province of British Columbia and are Canadian citizen or permanent residents are eligible for this award.

Duration and terms of award

One major scholarship with a total value of \$20 000 is available each year. In addition to the major scholarship, two minor scholarships of \$4 000 each are available for the two top runners-up to the major winner each year.

Fellowships are intended for study in formal postsecondary programs abroad.

Duration and terms of the award

There are 25 fellowships awarded each year. Fellowships are valued at \$10 000 and are non-renewable. Other awards may be held concurrently. The program abroad must be of one academic year (a minimum of eight consecutive months) including at least four months of taught courses.

Italian Government Scholarships

The Government of Italy offers scholarships to Canadian citizens (students, professionals, teachers, and artists) wishing to pursue studies in Italy.

Duration and terms of the awards

Short-term scholarships consist of a period from one to nine months and are reserved primarily for courses in Italian language and culture; long-term scholarships consist of a nine - to twelve-month period, they are awarded for specific research or specialised courses at public post-secondary institutions in any area of study, except for medical studies. Applicants must possess a high

school diploma at the time they apply and must be 35 years of age or younger; for those wishing to study or conduct research at the post-graduate level, the minimum requirement is a Master's degree. Italian language and culture courses of a one-month period are reserved for Italian language teachers to whom no age limit applies, and for 3rd year University students in the Italian Studies Department.
